Free at-home COVID-19 Testing

Testing is also available at local pharmacies, however, those that are uninsured will have to pay out-of-pocket costs.

Montclair Health Department offers free COVID testing Mondays and Tuesdays between 8:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m., 205 Claremont Avenue.

Free PCR and antigen testing is available for those uninsured, but they will need to bring a form of ID. No appointment or pre-registration necessary.

In addition to the Montclair Health Department, free public testing/treatment is available at Essex County Federally Qualified Health Centers. Please note that hours/days at these locations are subject to change, so calling ahead to ensure availability is advised.
