- Life After High School: The Montclair Fund for Educational Excellence 0 (MFEE), in partnership with Montclair High School, is bringing back its award-winning mini-conference, Life After High School. On February 24th from 10am-1pm, 8th-12th graders - and their caregivers - will gather at Montclair High School's George Inness Annex for this free, one-of-a-kind opportunity to connect and learn. Unlike a traditional college or job fair, Life After High School looks to leverage Montclair's amazing community members and alumni to share "wisdom nuggets" or small takeaways that will inspire adolescents through high school and beyond. There will be over 10 workshops on topics such as how to lean into your interests, how relationships can guide you through tough times, how to put yourself out there when you don't think you can, how to harness your superpowers (like ADHD) to lead you to success, and being okay with uncertainty. • <u>General Reminders</u>:

- **Cell Phone Use**: Students are not permitted to use their cell phones throughout the school day. This is stated in the school's code of conduct. Consequences will be issued for those who violate this rule.
- **Dress Appropriately for Weather:** Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the winter weather conditions, particularly outdoor recess.
- **Attendance Information**: Student attendance and tardiness is an issue with some of students. Students with ten tardies will receive an afterschool detention will be issued. Additionally, attendance records affect your child's ability to attend/participate in end of the year events/field trips.
- Student Attire: We continue to have serious concerns over students dressing appropriately for middle school, especially with footwear. Slides, Crocs, flip flops, and any shoes without a backing <u>are not permitted</u>, as they do not have a back to the shoes. Referrals will be issued for inappropriate footwear, as indicated in the Code of Conduct.
