- o **Student Behavior Contracts:** 8th grade behavior contracts were issued on Friday, March 1st. 6th and 7th grade behavior contracts were issued on Wednesday, March 6th. Please review the contracts with your child at home so you are aware about the requirements to participate in the end of the year trips/activities.
- Cell Phone Use: Students are not permitted to use their cell phones throughout the school day. This is stated in the school's code of conduct. Consequences will be issued for those who violate this rule.
- O Dress Appropriately for Weather: Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the winter weather conditions, particularly outdoor recess.
- o **Attendance Information**: Student attendance and tardiness is an issue with some of students. Students with ten tardies will receive an afterschool detention will be issued. Additionally, attendance records affect your child's ability to attend/participate in end of the year events/field trips.
- o **Student Attire**: We continue to have serious concerns over students dressing appropriately for middle school, especially with footwear. Slides, Crocs, flip flops, and any shoes without a backing are not permitted, as

they do not have a back to the shoes. Referrals will be issued for inappropriate footwear, as indicated in the Code of Conduct.
