- Attendance Information: Student attendance and tardiness is an issue with some of students. Effective as of Monday, October 23rd, student attendance has been closely monitored, as there are quite a few students who are chronically late. This is not only disruptive for the student who is late, but also to the class as well. Parents—we appreciate your help and support in ensuring you're your children get to school on time each day. Students with ten tardies will receive an afterschool detention will be issued.
- Important Information Regarding Student Attire: We continue to have serious concerns over students dressing appropriately for middle school, especially with footwear. Slides, Crocs, flip flops, and any shoes without a backing are not permitted, as they do not have a back to the shoes. This presents a serious safety issue. As a school, we have been lenient, but we can no longer allow this. Recently, students have fallen in the stairwell and outside, and several of these students were not wearing the required footwear. Additionally, this is a safety requirement for when we conduct safety drills. Moving forward, referrals will be issued for inappropriate footwear, as indicated in the Code of Conduct.
