#### **Buzz Aldrin Mission Statement:**

- Empathy Advisory Information: This week, our students participated in an advisory centered around empathy. Students learned the definition of empathy, the different types of empathy, ways to show or express empathy towards others, and discussed the impact empathy has on promoting healthy relationships. Afterwards, they had an opportunity to review various real-life scenarios and share what they felt would be the most appropriate way to show empathy in that situation. - Attendance Information: Student attendance and tardiness is an issue with some of students. - Important Information Regarding Student Attire: We continue to have serious concerns over students dressing appropriately for middle school, especially with footwear. Slides, Crocs, flip flops, and any shoes without a

backing are not permitted, as they do not have a back to the shoes. This presents a serious safety issue. As a school, we have been lenient, but we can no longer allow this. Recently, students have fallen in the stairwell and outside, and several of these students were not wearing the required footwear. Additionally, this is a safety requirement for when we conduct safety drills. Moving forward, referrals will be issued for inappropriate footwear, as indicated in the Code of Conduct.
