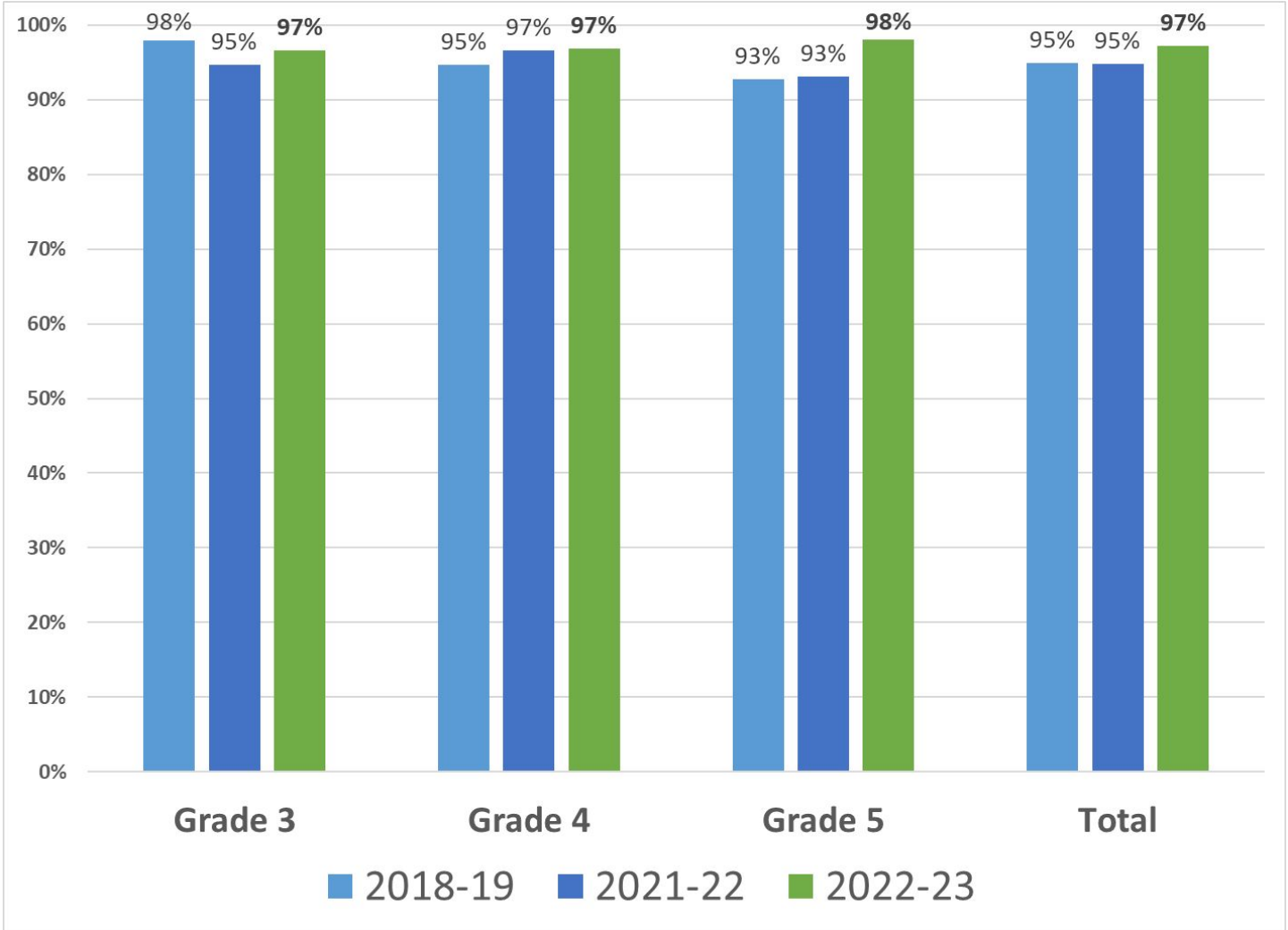

## NJSLA ELA HIGHLIGHTS

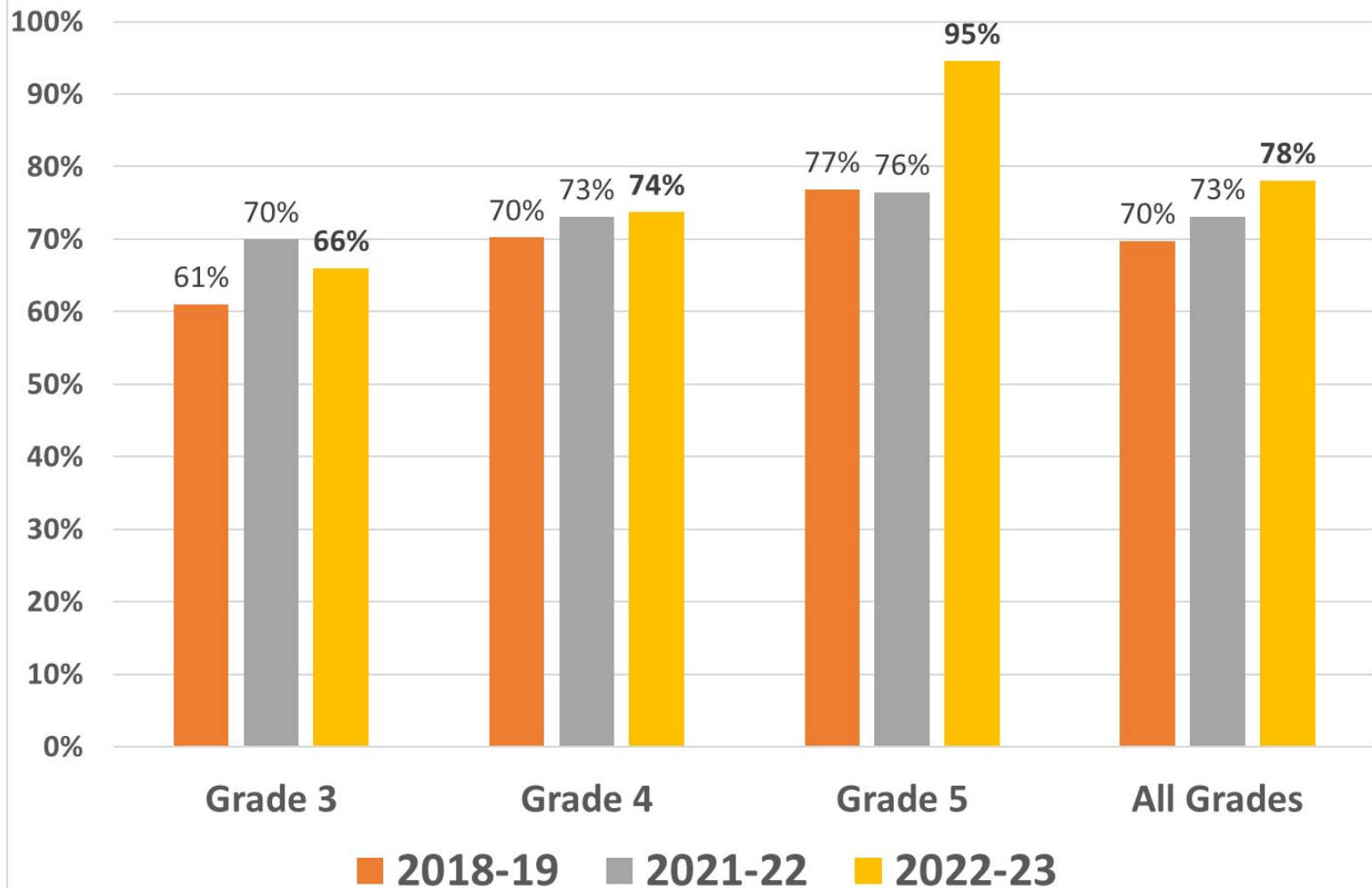
- 97% of Hillside students took the NJSLA assessments in 2023, up from 95% in 2022.
- The % of Hillside 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding grade-level expectations in ELA fell from 70% in 2022 to 66% in 2023, but still exceeded the state average of 42%. The % of 4<sup>th</sup> meeting/exceeding expectations upticked to 75% in 2024.
- The % of Hillside 5th grade students meeting or exceeding grade-level expectations in ELA jumped from 76% in 2022 to an exceptionally high 95% in 2023.

# NJSLA PARTICIPATION RATES HILLSIDE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, GRADES 3-5

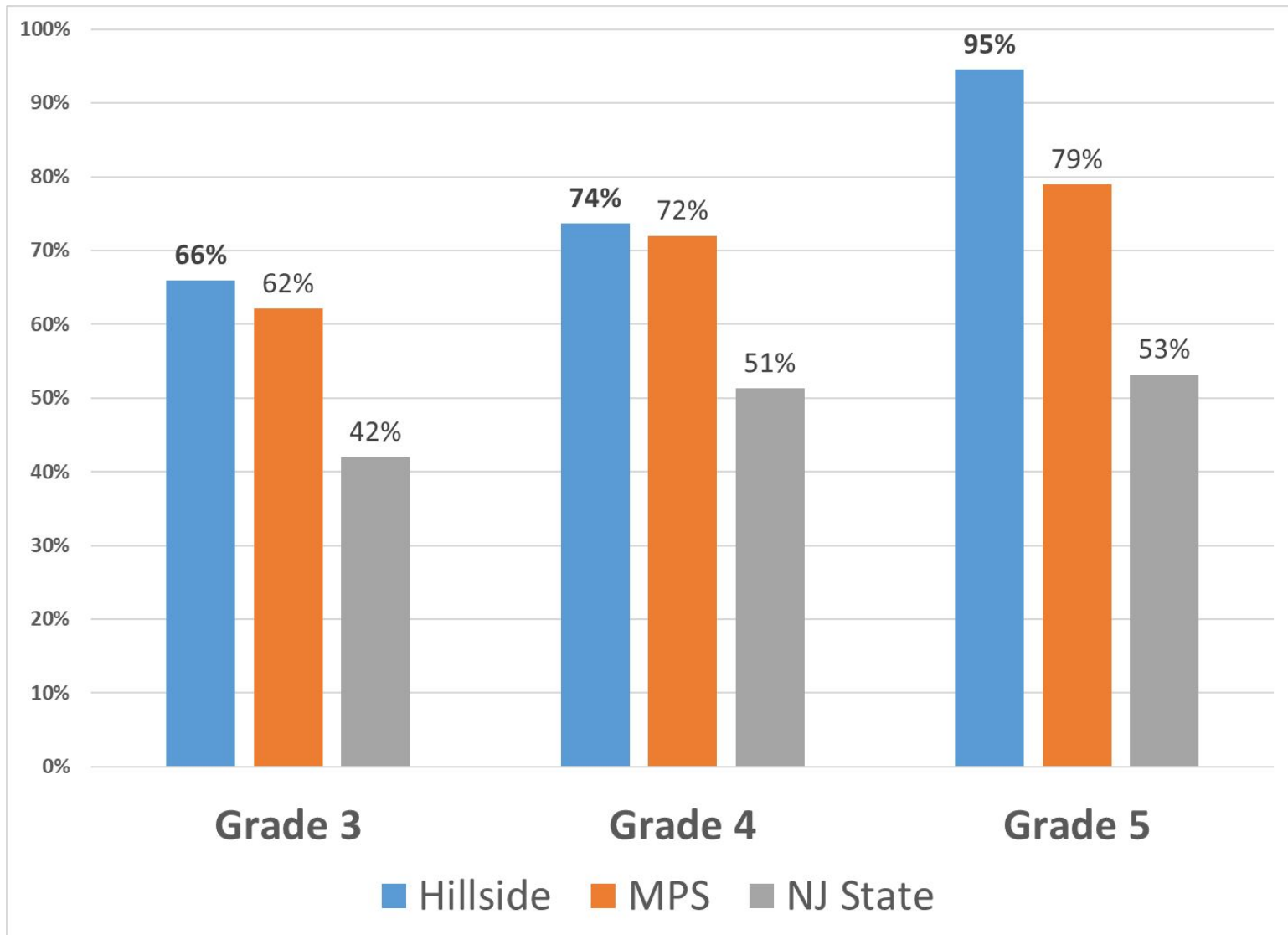


# NJSLA ELA THREE-YEAR TREND HILLSIDE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

## % Meeting/Exceeding Grade-Level Expectations

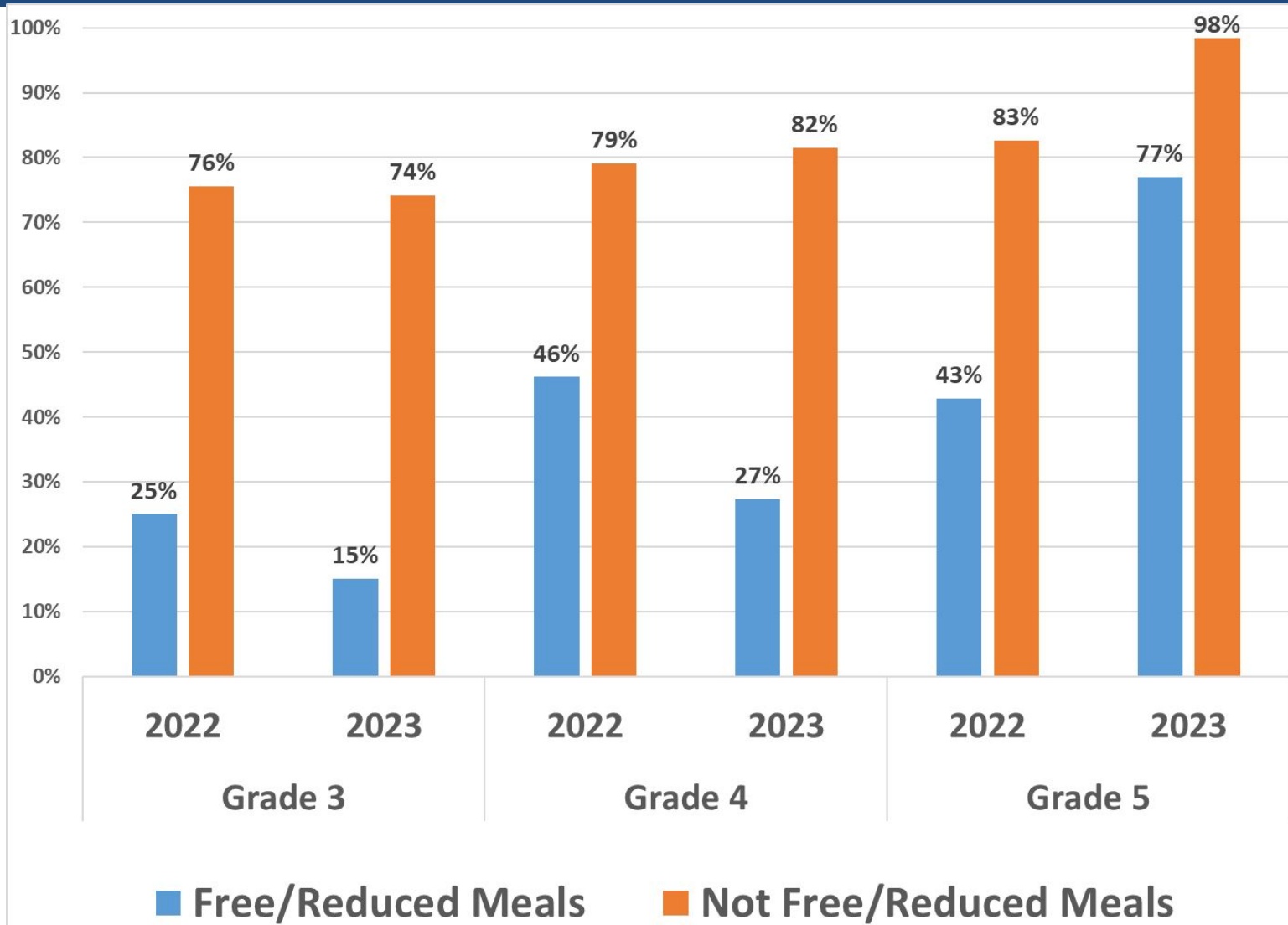


COMPARISON OF **HILLSIDE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** TO MPS AND NJ STATE

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS: % MEETING/EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS



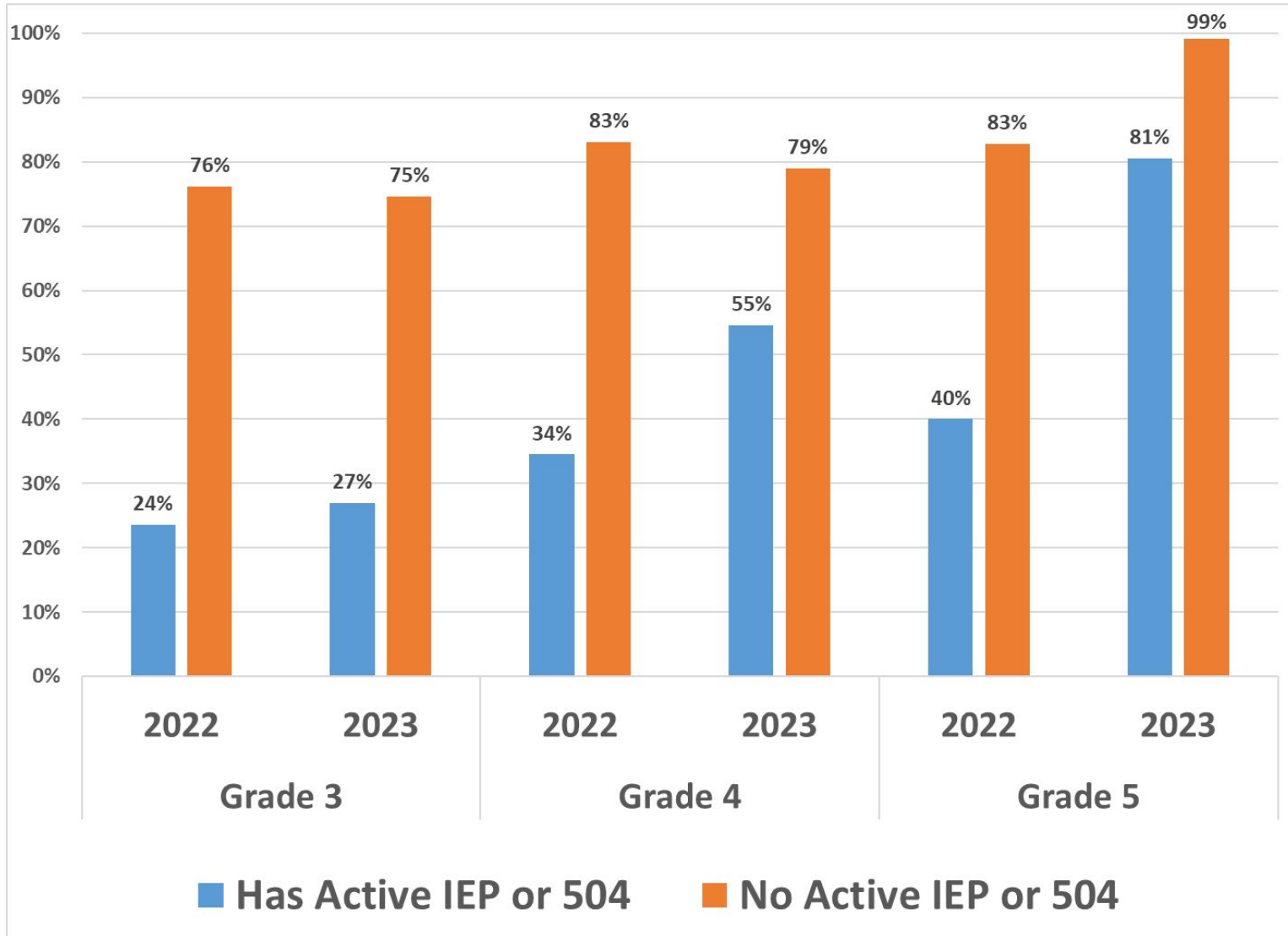

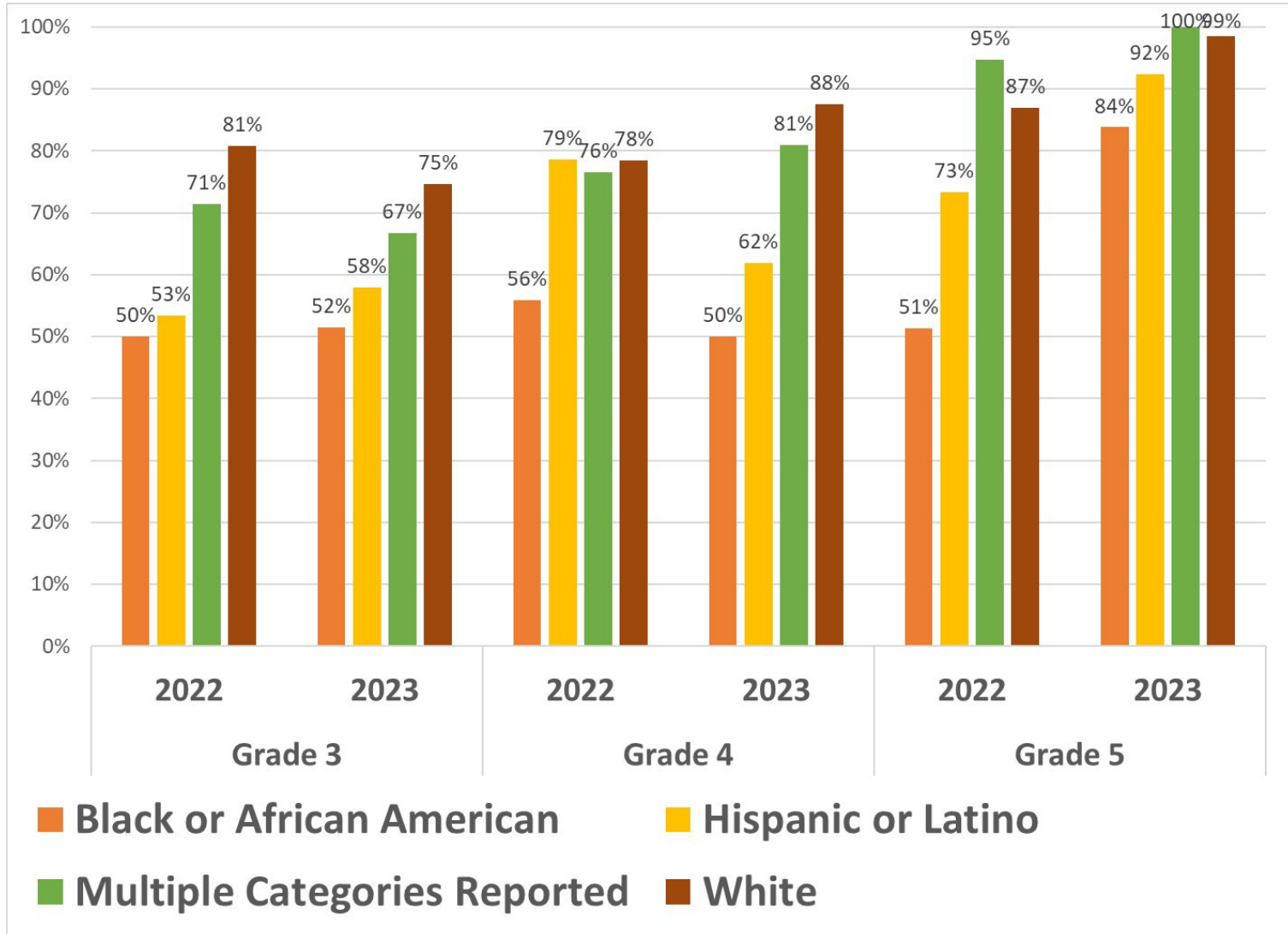




PERFORMANCE OF STUDENTS WITH ACTIVE IEPS OR 504S

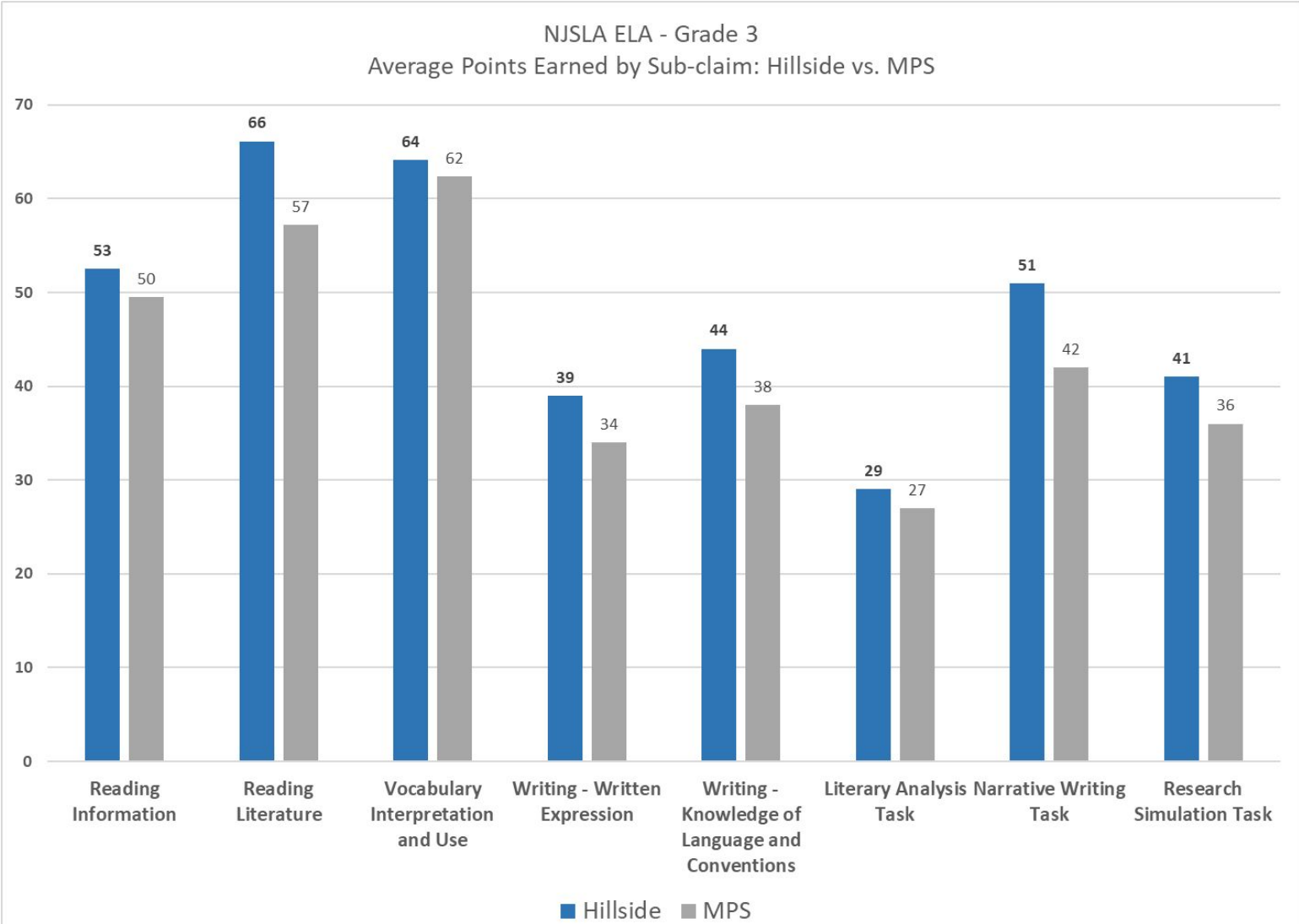

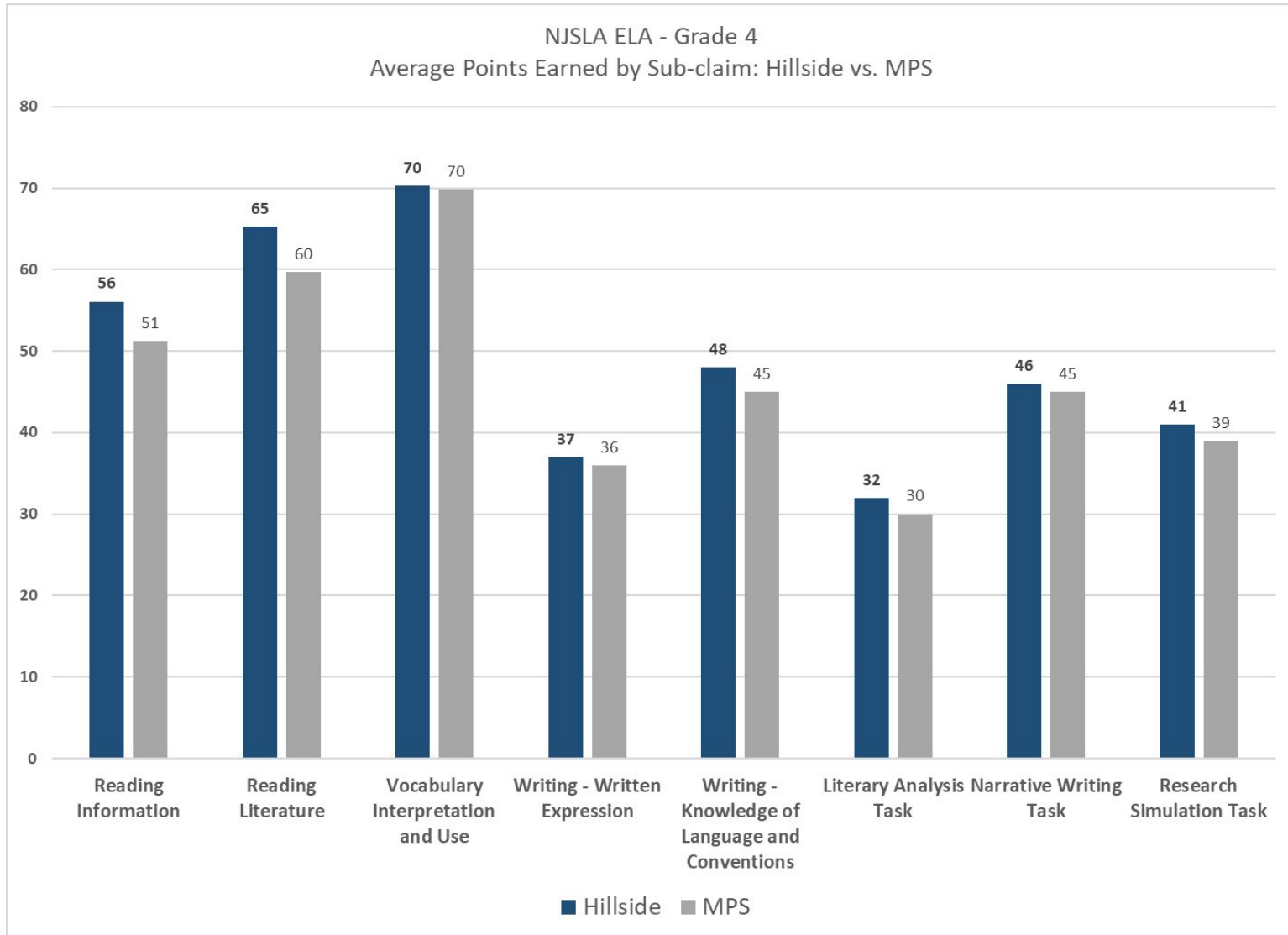
## NJSLA ELA CONTENT STANDARDS

- Breaking down the NJSLA ELA results by sub-claim, Hillside students generally scored the highest in Vocabulary Interpretation & Use, followed by Reading Literature and Reading Information.
- On the three writing tasks, Hillside students were strongest on the Narrative Writing Task, followed by the Literary Analysis Task and Research Simulation Task. They generally exceeded district averages on the writing tasks, most notably at the 5<sup>th</sup> grade level.

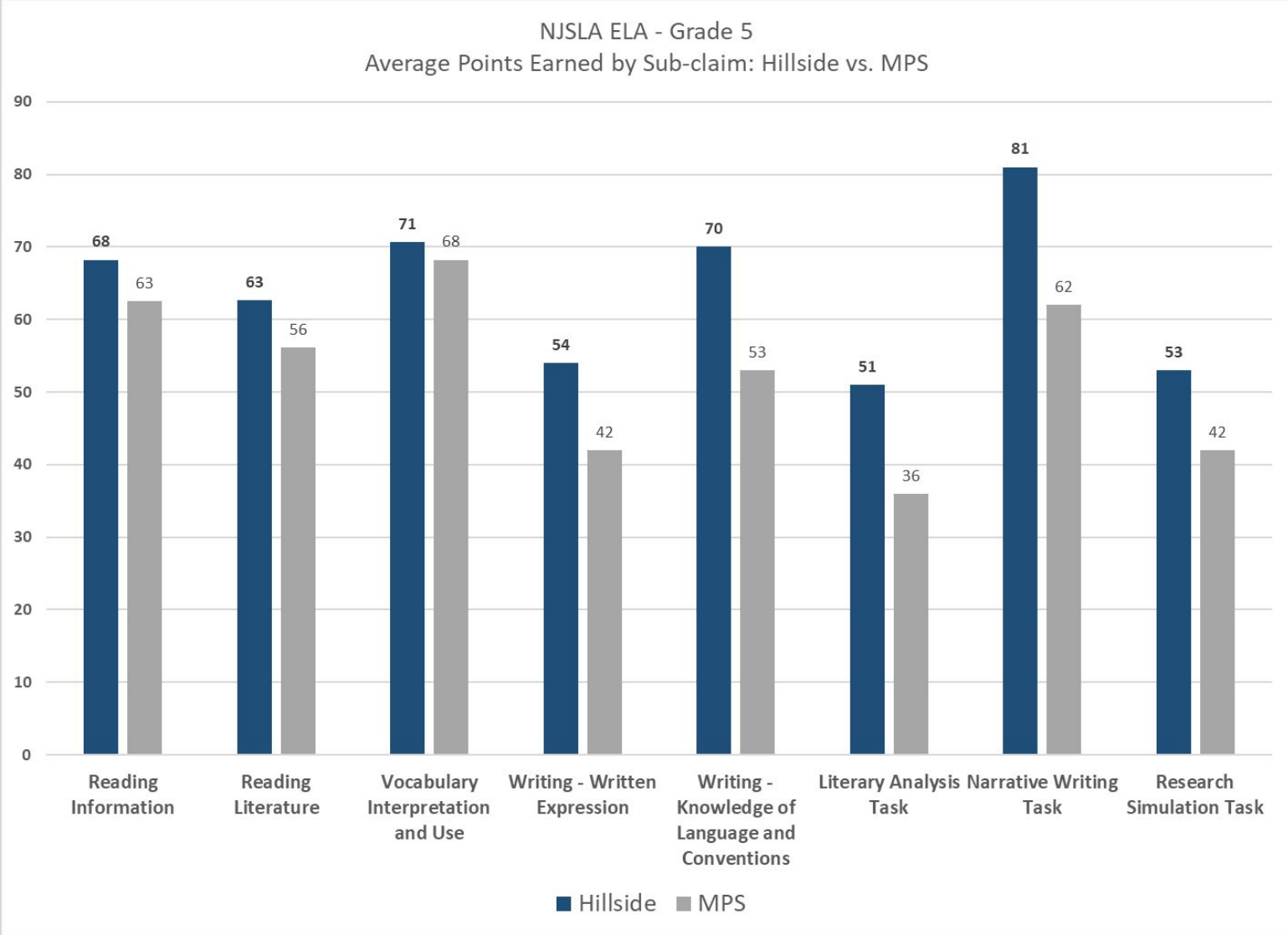
**SPRING 2023 NJSLA ELA – GRADE 3**

**AVERAGE POINTS EARNED BY CONTENT AREA (MAX 100)**



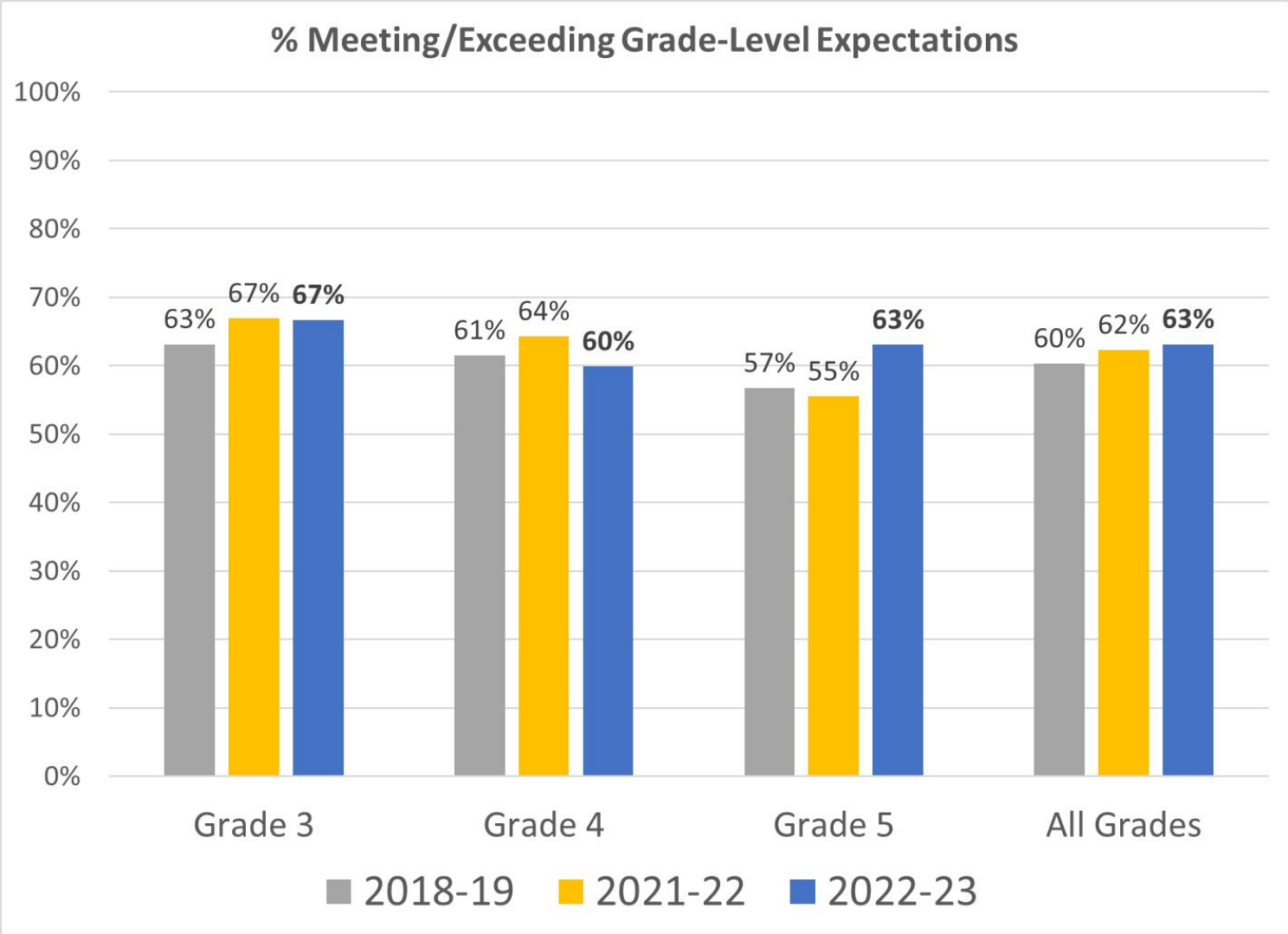
**SPRING 2023 NJSLA ELA – GRADE 5**

# NJSLA MATHEMATICS HIGHLIGHTS

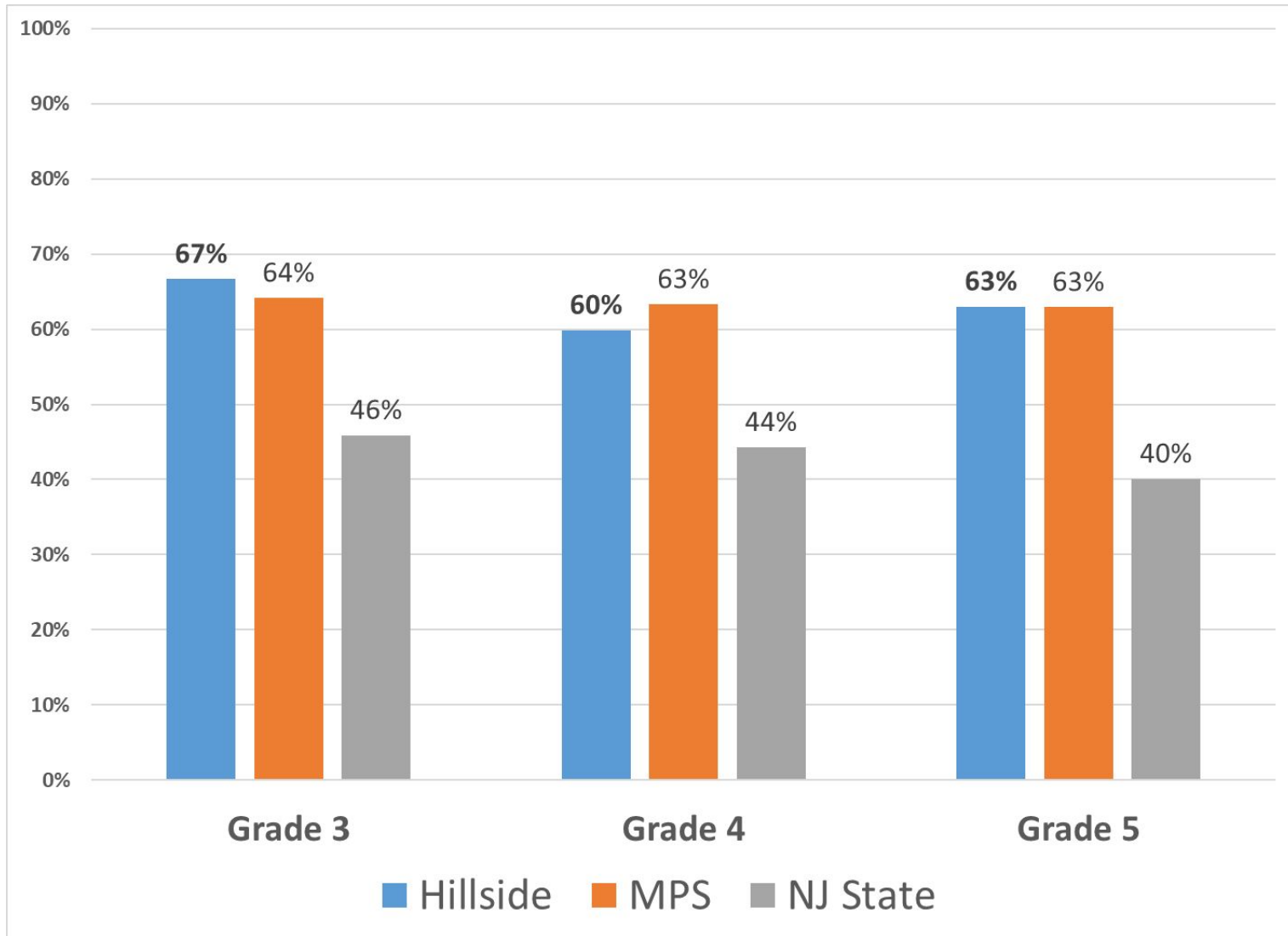
- The % of students meeting or exceeding expectations in NJSLA Mathematics at Hillside upticked from 62% overall in 2022 to 63% in 2023.
- The % of 5<sup>th</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding expectations at Hillside rose from 55% in 2022 to 64% in 2023, while the % meeting/exceeding in Math for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> graders trended flat to downward year-over-year.
- As with the ELA results, there continue to be significant gaps between the performance of students receiving free or reduced-price meals or students of color and overall averages.

# NJSLA MATH THREE-YEAR TREND HILLSIDE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL



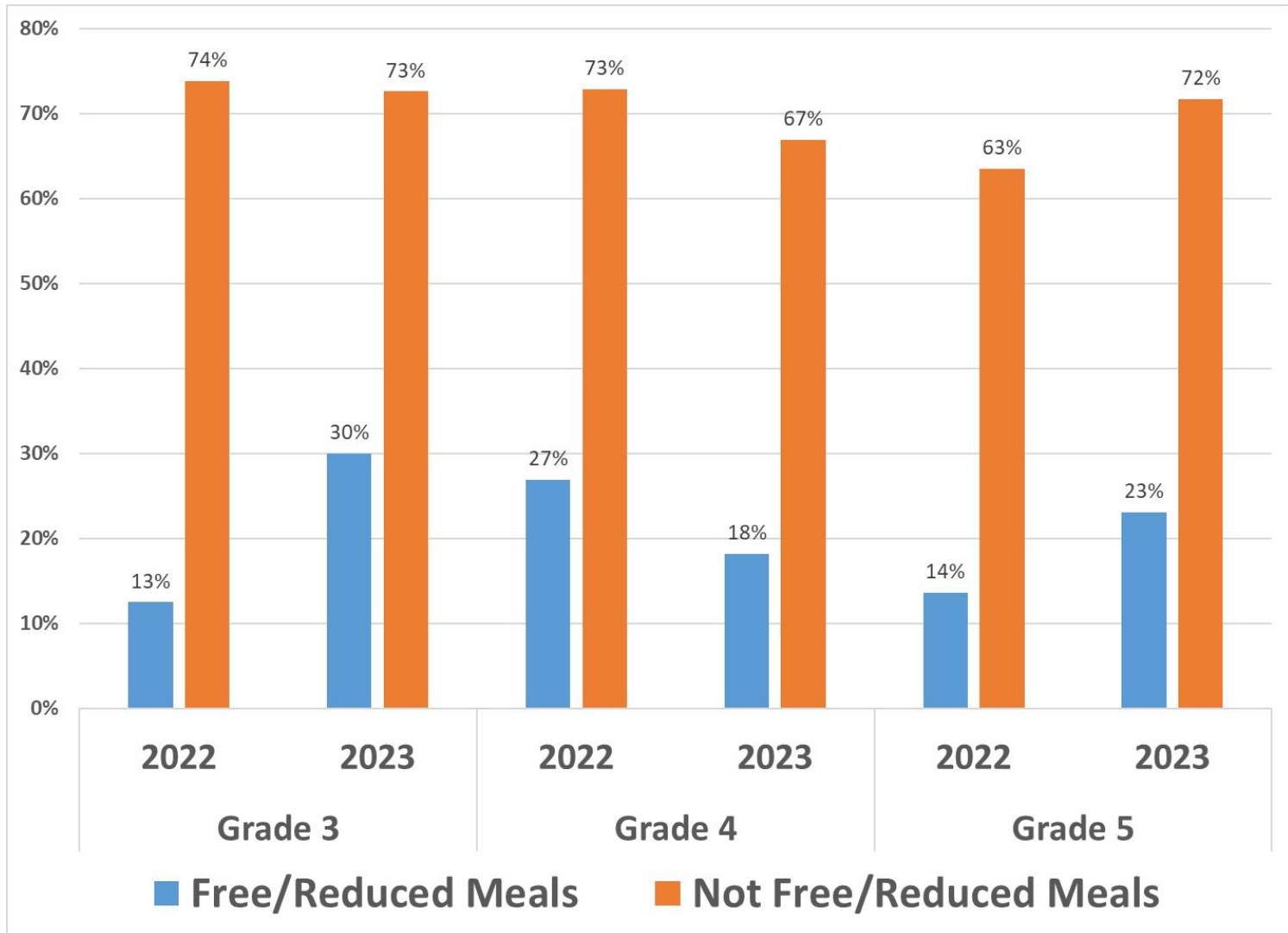


COMPARISON OF **HILLSIDE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** TO MPS AND NJ STATE

MATH: % MEETING/EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS

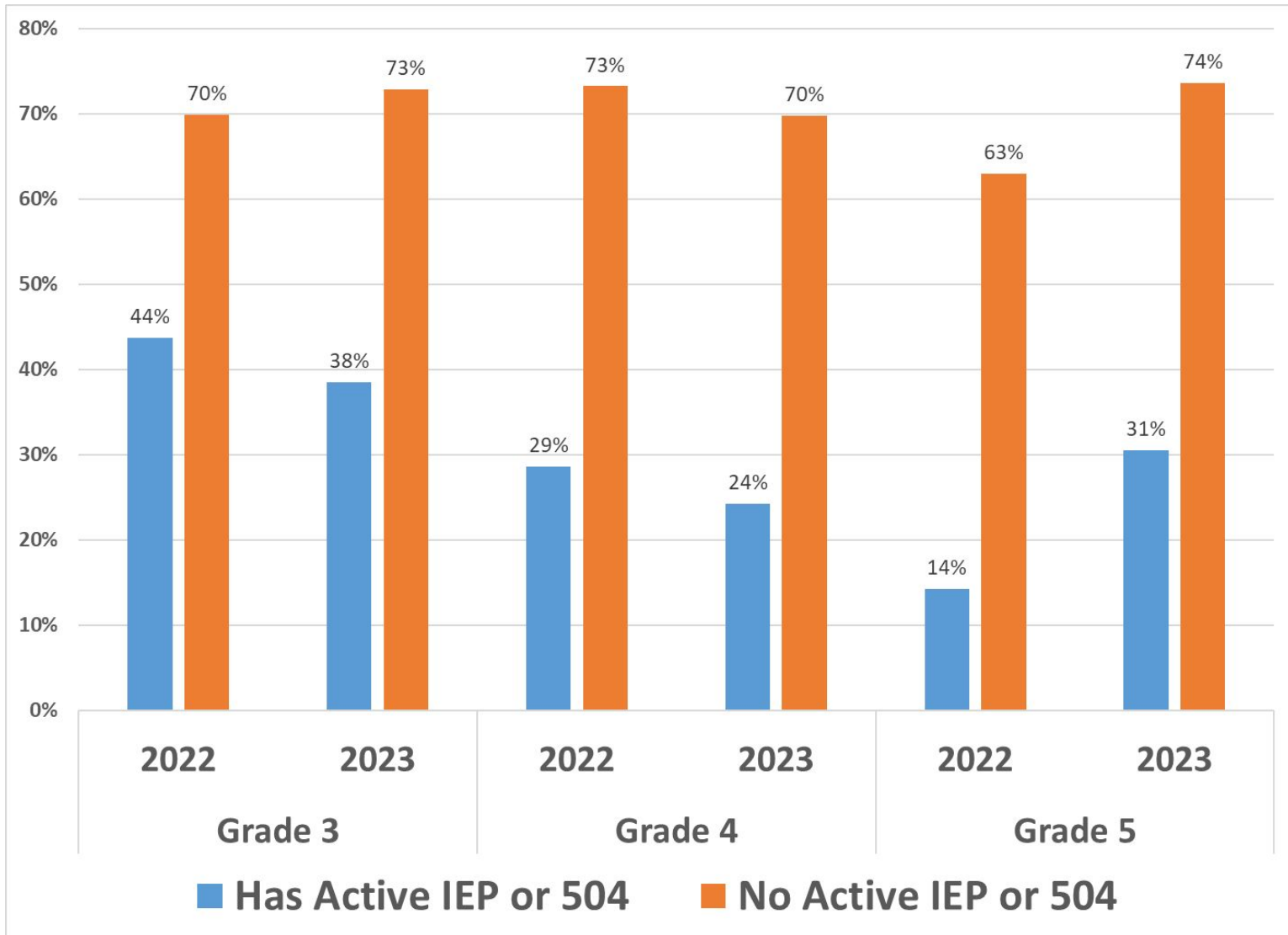

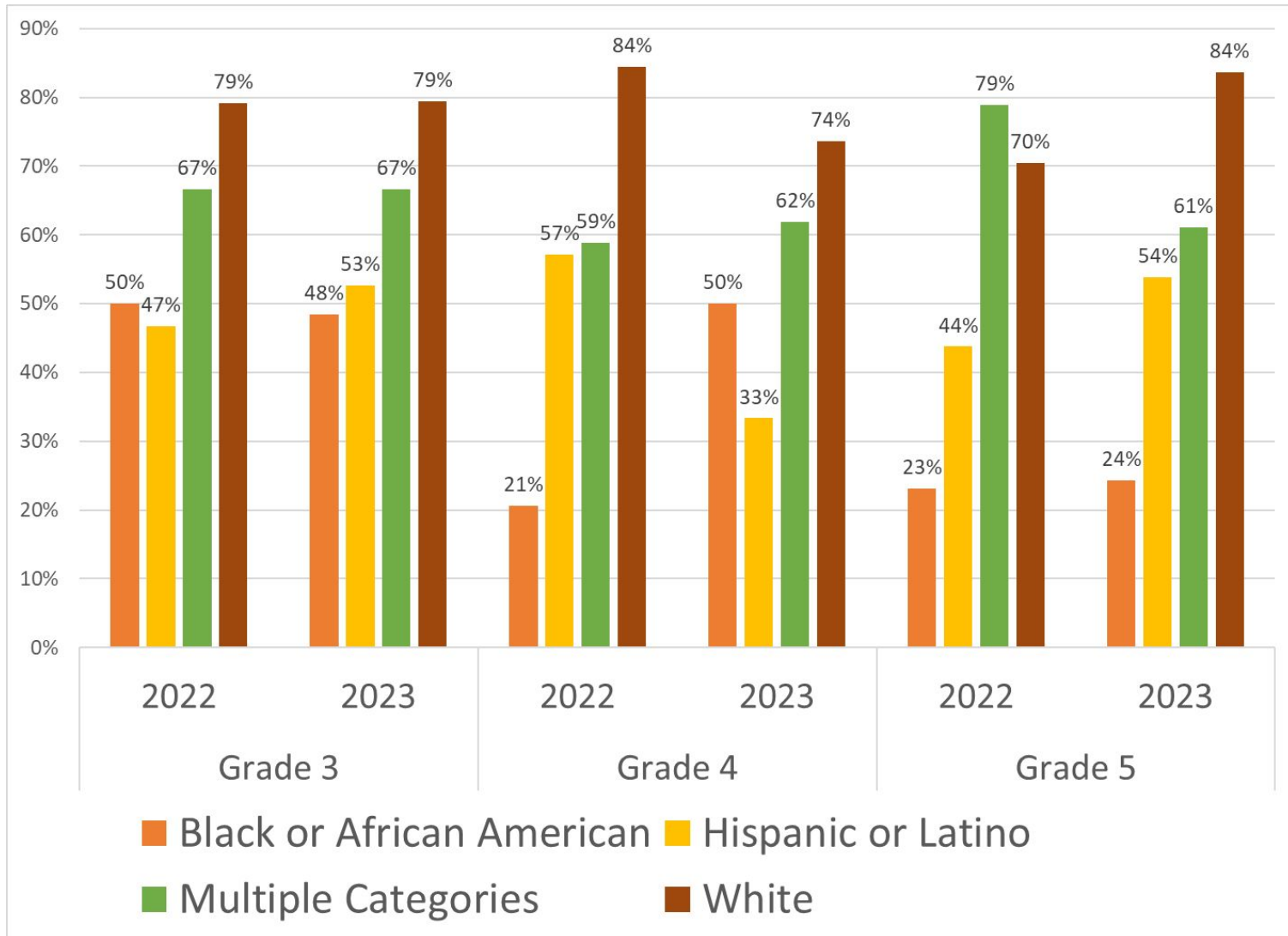
## % MEETING/EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS IN NJSLA MATHEMATICS

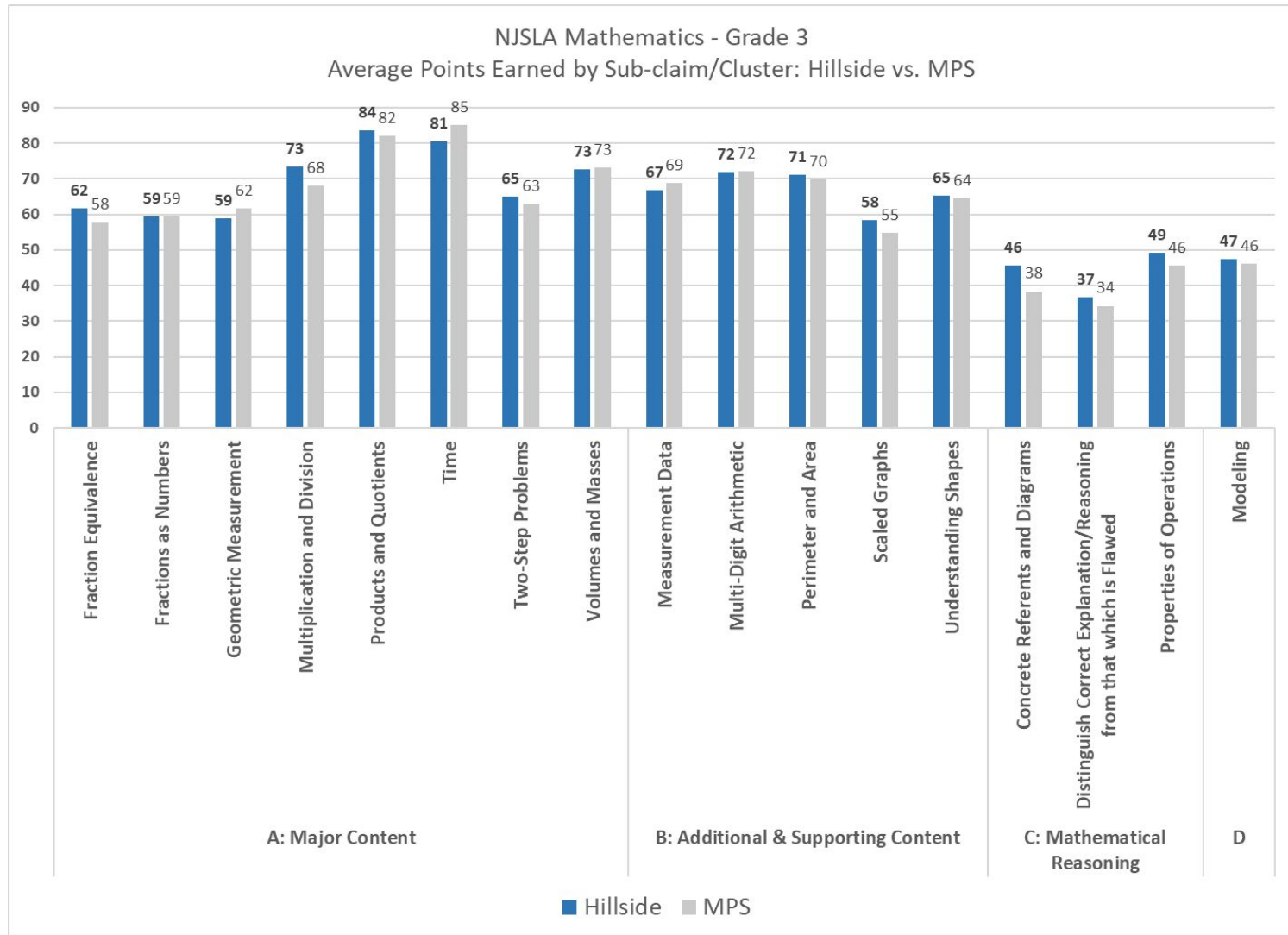

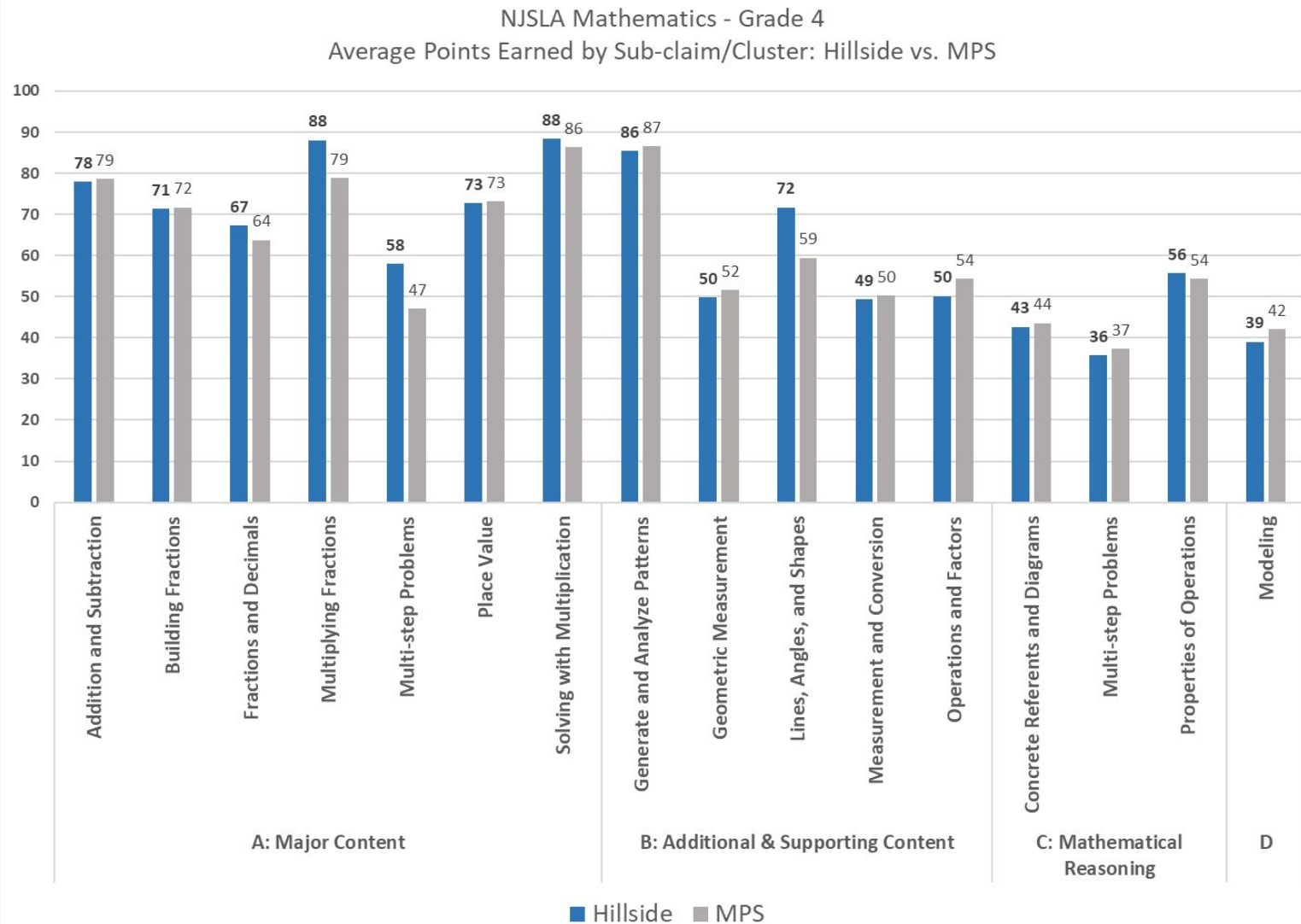
## NJSLA MATH CONTENT STANDARDS

- Looking at Hillside's results within NJSLA-Math's content standards, students were in line with or slightly above district averages in most Major Content and Additional & Supporting Content areas. Weaker areas included the Mathematical Reasoning and Modeling/Application domains.
